### CITRUS FOR THE PATIO

Did you know that Colorado has a great climate for growing citrus trees in a pot on the patio? Did you know that dwarf varieties do very well in the house over the winter? It's true! Here at *The Flower Bin*, we have many varieties and sizes of dwarf citrus, all handpicked to do well in your home. Here is a sampling of what we carry:

### **Lime Bearss Seedless**

True lime. Fruit is larger than the key lime. Bears fruit year-round.

### **Dwarf Mexican Key Lime**

Small fruit with great lime flavor. Bears fruit year-round.

### Meyer Lemon Improved

Very juicy and sweeter than most lemons. Flowers and fruits year-round.

### **Orange Lane Late Navel Orange**

Navel orange with fine rich flavor. Fruit ripens spring through summer.

### <u>Miho Wase Mandarin</u> –

3" fruit is sweet and juicy with thin skin. Ready to harvest near Thanksgiving.

### **Shiranu Mandarin**

Intensely sweet very large mandarin. Easy to peel. Harvest January through March.

All citrus, here in Colorado, prefer a partial shade position on the patio, and a nice bright south or west window in the house. Allow the soil to dry out a bit between waterings. Feed with citrus fertilizer every 3-4 months. Please bring it inside before the first frost/freeze in the fall and you will have fresh citrus for years to come!
