#### CITRUS!

Did you know that Colorado has a great climate for growing citrus trees on the patio? Did you know that the dwarf varieties do very well inside the house in the winter? It's true! Here at *The Flower Bin*, we have many varieties of dwarf citrus trees, all hand picked to do well in your home. Here is a list of what we currently have:

**Nagami Kumquat** - Clusters of small, tart, orange fruit.

**Clementine Mandarin** - Produces sweet, juicy fruit.

**Washington Navel Orange** - 6-8 ft. Best orange for indoors. Seedless.

*Moro Blood Orange* - Unique red fleshed orange.

*Owari Mandarin* - Sweet, delicious oranges. Easy peeling.

**Bearrs Persian Lime** - Large seedless fruit. **Mexican Lime (Key Lime)** - Small golf ball size fruit.

**Eureka Lemon** - Large crop of fruit all year long.

**Oro Blanco Grapefruit** - Sweet seedless yellow fruit.

**Meyer Lemon** - Very juicy and sweeter than most lemons.

All citrus, grown here in Colorado, prefer a partial shade spot on the patio, and a nice bright south or west window in the house. Allow tree to dry out a bit in between watering. Feed with a citrus fertilizer every 3-4 months. Please keep it from frost and freeze and you will have fresh citrus for years to come.

## A Week for Pollianators - June 20th-26th

Pollinators are insects and small animals like birds, butterflies, and bees that pollinate plants and make our gardens and world greener.

#### **COMBINE AND BENEFIT**

Summer is almost here and the herbs are begging to become a part of your garden. Consider combinations of plant that benefit each other. For example, planting basil a foot away from tomato plants will increase tomatoes



yield. It also improves the taste of lettuce. Broccoli benefits from many herbs like basil, chamomile, dill, mint, rosemary, and thyme. Chives will improve flavor for carrots, and rosemary deters carrot flies. Dill and basil are natural protectants for tomato plants.

Marigold are garden championsthey attract bees and other pollinators, ward off harmful nematodes and make such a pretty border.
